Year 4

Mathematics and Numeracy	Create a tally chart of how many conflicts you see in stories or TV programmes during one week.	Time how long it takes you and someone in your home to solve a small disagreement. Record the time and compare the results.
Languages, Literacy and Communication	Write a short story about two characters who have a disagreement and how they solve it.	Create a comic strip showing a conflict and how it is solved.
Science and Technology	Build a simple model shield or defence using materials at home and explain how it protects people.	Research how technology helps people communicate to solve problems (phones, video calls). Present your findings.
Expressive Arts	Design a symbol of peace and explain what the symbol means.	Act out a short drama scene showing a conflict and how it is solved. You could perform it for your family.
Humanities	Research a famous castle in Wales such as Cardiff Castle and explain why castles were built during times of conflict.	Interview a family member about a disagreement they had as a child and how they solved it.
Health and Well-being	Create a kindness challenge for your family and record how it helps prevent arguments.	Keep a short reflection diary for one week. Write about a time you solved a problem calmly.
